**Commitment to achieving Net Zero:**

Pacific Computers Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2032.

**Baseline Emissions Footprint:**

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Our baseline calculations do include a number of averages due to the need to estimate scope 3 emissions in the supply chain. We have used averages of overnight packet and pallet deliveries, for example.

**Emissions Reduction Targets:**

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Within our baseline year, we predicted that carbon emissions would decrease over the following four years to 4,500 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2027, totalling a reduction of 78.6%. We have since achieved a 98.3% reduction by 2026, meaning that we have exceeded our interim target. Our intention is now to remove scope 1 and 2 entirely by 2030.

**Carbon Reduction Projects:**

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2021-2022 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 20,689.93 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, a 98.3% reduction against the 2021-2022 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract:

- Addressing scope 3 with more accurate reporting from our suppliers to reduce assumptions/estimations.
- Widespread electrification of our company vehicles.
- Use of low-energy lighting in our buildings.
- Reducing business mileage through the use of local engineering resources and heightened planning.
- ISO 14001/ISO 50001 accreditation.
- Working with our suppliers to further lower scope 3 emissions by reducing deliveries through improved planning.

- Reusing supplier packaging in-house wherever possible.
- Banning single-use coffee cups from our premises.
- Recycling all wooden pallets through a dedicated waste partner.
- Switching to a zero-carbon electricity contract.

Further/ongoing measures we are planning to meet our targets include:

- Reduction of Scope 1 emissions by changing the building's hot water supply and installing solar panels/insulation.
- Converting more of our company vehicle fleet to electric.
- Favouring suppliers who are willing to work with us to reduce our scope 3 upstream distribution emissions and continuing to consolidate our deliveries.
- Introducing schemes to encourage staff to carshare/walk/cycle/take public transport to work wherever possible.
- Exploring partnership with logistics companies who use electric vehicles to reduce our scope 3 downstream distribution emissions.
- Reducing waste to landfill by donating more used hardware to community projects and charities, as well as placing more business with suppliers who offer upgradable systems.

In addition, Pacific is now looking into options for offsetting residual carbon emissions, including Project Seagrass, and aims to have offsetting methods in place by the end of the current financial year.

### **Declaration and Sign-Off:**

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.
